General Rules and Bylaws

1. Pageants are categorized as follows and may be changed by the Pageant Committee as deemed necessary.

Baby Miss: Birth - 12months Toddler Miss: 13 months-3 years Little Miss: 4 years-6 years Junior Miss: 7 years-9 years

Pre-Teen Miss: 10 years- 12 years Teen Miss: 13 years-15 years Miss 16 years-21 years Special Needs: All ages

***Each age Division will have 3 Winners: Second Alternate, First Alternate, Division Queen**

*** Two Grand Supremes will be crowned : 0-9 and 10-21**

1. Contestants must arrive no earlier than 30 minutes before their given pageant start time. No facilities will be available to contestants to get ready at City Hall.
2. Visitors **WILL NOT BE** permitted backstage 10 minutes prior to pageant starting. See below for exceptions.
3. The number of contestants allowed in each age decision will be at the discretion of the Miss Locust Grove Pageant Committee. The Pageant Committee reserves the right to combine age groups in any age division.
4. Contestants **MUST** meet the requirements for each division by or on pageant date. In the event that a parent/guardian/responsible party provides false or inaccurate application information, upon proven falsification, contestant will be disqualified and any crown/title will be forfeited to the first runner-up.
5. This is a **NATURAL** Pageant. Contestant's attire and makeup should be age appropriate and may consist of: **Baby, Toddler, Little Miss & Special Needs-** Sunday dress or pageant dress. Shoes & socks required. **Junior-** Floor-length Evening gown. **Teen & Miss-** Floor Length Evening gown.
6. Escorts for children, who need them, are allowed. Escorts will **NOT** be taken into account for scoring. Appropriate attire for escorts may consist of: **Female Escorts-** Sunday dress, dress slacks, blouse, etc. **ABSOLUTELY** no low necklines, see-through apparel, short shorts, skirts or dresses will be allowed. **Male Escorts-** dress slacks, dress shirt, polo shirt, etc. You may wear a tux.
7. Upon commencement of the pageant, contestants are under the jurisdiction of the Miss Locust Grove Pageant Officials.
8. The MLGPC encourages friends and relatives to attend the pageant, but at no time are they to visit backstage with contestants. Only **ONE** person per child will be allowed backstage during the pageant. This can be a parent or an escort, **NOT** both. Any items to be given to the contestants after the pageant has begun should go through a pageant official.
9. Applications of all contestants will be kept confidential. Entry fees may be paid by cash, check or money order. Checks must be made payable to Locust Grove Events Committee A \$35 charge will be applied on all returned checks.

10. Photogenic judging is optional and does not count towards contestant's scores. Judges are not made aware of who does or does not participate in this event. Only one photogenic award will be given in each category. Must be a current, 5x7 or 8x10 photo. No frames. Be sure name and Division is written on the back. Picture must be received "IN HAND" on day of pageant at registration. Pictures will be available for pick up in dressing rooms prior to announcing winners.
11. Judging will be done by qualified personnel. No family members, friends, and/or significant others of the current applicants or reigning will be allowed to judge any Miss Locust Grove Pageant. Judge panels are limited to no more than five (5) and no less than three (3) judges.
12. Judges decisions will be accepted as official and final. NO SCORES will be given out under any circumstances. A point scale will be used in the various divisions as deemed necessary by the Pageant Committee. Scores of contestants will be kept confidential. All materials are shredded after the pageant.
13. Pictures of the winners, runners-up, and photogenic will be made immediately after each age divisions' crowning. Winners will be escorted off stage. No one is allowed on stage. Please do not block center aisle or sides where contestants may be exiting or entering the stage area.
D. No contestant can serve as winner in the same division consecutively (2 years back to back, must be one year in between wins) . The reigning title holder may crown or compete, not both.
14. The MLGPC requires the newly crowned winners to perform the following duties:
 - i. Personal appearance in the Locust Grove Day Parade on Saturday, April 22, 2017.
 - ii. Personal appearance in the Locust Grove Christmas Parade on Saturday, December 2, 2017
 - iii. Help with next year's pageant All title winners are responsible for returning the next year to crown their successors. Winners must ride in the current year's parade.
16. Parents/Guardians shall not hold any member of the pageant committee, liable or responsible for any property damaged, lost, or stolen during the competition.
